M.Sc. Botany Students Explore Biodiversity at Kadalundi Bird Sanctuary

The Third Semester M.Sc. Botany students visited Kadalundi Bird Sanctuary on 12th June 2025 as part of their academic field study. The visit was organized to provide practical exposure to biodiversity, ecosystem dynamics, and conservation strategies. Accompanied by faculty members, the students observed a wide variety of flora and fauna, including numerous species of migratory and resident birds. The sanctuary, located in Kerala's Malappuram district, is a hotspot of biodiversity, especially known for its rich mangrove forests and estuarine ecosystem. During the visit, students engaged in identifying plant species, studying ecological interactions, and understanding the significance of wetland conservation. The field trip offered an opportunity to bridge classroom learning with real-world ecological observations. 


EXPLORING GREEN SCIENCE

As part of the academic curriculum, the 4th semester M.Sc. Botany students undertook an educational field visit to the Plant Tissue Culture Laboratory at the prestigious Arya Vaidya Sala, Kottakkal, on 17th June 2025. The visit was aimed at providing students with practical exposure to the methods and applications of plant tissue culture — a vital component of modern plant biotechnology. The students were warmly welcomed by the research and technical staff, who offered a comprehensive overview of the lab's functioning. A detailed session was conducted explaining various stages of tissue culture including explant selection, sterilization, media preparation, inoculation, subculturing, and acclimatization. The team also demonstrated the micropropagation of several medicinal plants that are extensively used in Ayurvedic formulations. This hands-on exposure greatly enriched the students' understanding of the commercial and research significance of tissue culture in preserving rare and endangered medicinal species. The visit concluded with an interactive Q&A session, during which students actively engaged with the experts to clarify their doubts and gain deeper insights into the subject. Overall, the visit proved to be a valuable learning experience, bridging the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical application in the field of plant biotechnology.

Turning Pages, Igniting Minds: Reading Day Celebration 2025



STRENGTH IN MIND AND BODY




FINANCIAL LITERACY ORIENTATION

Future Forward: Developing Leaders Through Teamwork


